Alabama's 200th Birthday

Participation Open to All

The Alabama Bicentennial Commission encourages all K-12 schools (public, private, and homeschool) to participate in the celebration of our state's 200th birthday. By completing the School Participation Form at Alabama200.org, any educational entity can receive a governor's commendation and a bicentennial flag for display at its school.

Bicentennial School Designation

Schools desiring to achieve the **Alabama Bicentennial School** designation must develop a proposal for a community outreach and improvement project that will connect classrooms with their local communities. These connections foster an appreciation for the vital role of civic engagement in the life and work of a strong community and state.

Applicants selected for the **Alabama Bicentennial School** designation will receive a \$2,000 grant to support implementation of the proposed project. Selected schools will also receive the **Bicentennial Schools Toolkit**, which includes the bicentennial logo, brand guidelines for usage, and tips for completing a successful project. **Project Application Forms**, available at Alabama200.org, are due by **March 31, 2018**. Up to 200 applicants will be selected.

Bicentennial Schools of Excellence

Twenty-one schools, three from each of Alabama's seven Congressional districts, will be recognized as **Bicentennial Schools of Excellence**. These schools will participate in commemoration ceremonies in Montgomery on **December 14, 2019**. In order to qualify, an Alabama Bicentennial School must submit a final report on its project. A review committee will base selections on the reports, which are due on **August 1, 2019**.
